- 2. Date of Death
- 3. Location of Death
- 4. Date of Funeral or Memorial Services
- 5. Time of Funeral or Memorial Services
- 6. Location of Funeral or Memorial Services
- 7. Assembly Location for Attending Chapter Members
- 8. Time for Assembly of Attending Chapter Members
- 9. Dress Code for Attending Chapter Members

- 10. Person in Charge of Attending Chapter Members
- 11. Person Answering Roll Call on Behalf of Deceased Chapter Member
- 12. Function to be Performed at Deceased Funeral or Memorial Services

Functions To Be Provided at Deceased's Funeral or Memorial Services

- 1. Comments about Deceased Chapter Member by Person in Charge
- 2. Singing and playing of the "Ballad of the Green Berets" by Attending Chapter Members
- 3. If applicable, presentation of any of the following awards to Deceased's Next of Kin
 - a. Framed Certificate of Appreciation
 - b. Chapter 32-50 Challenge Coin with Deceased's Name & Membership Number etched on coin
 - c. SFA Award of Excellence Medal and Ribbon Presentation Kit

Last Roll Call Functions by Attending Chapter Members

- 1. Person in Charge (PIC) will prepare list of attending Chapter members for roll call purposes.
- 2. At the designated appropriate time in service, the PIC will make any appropriate remarks about the deceased chapter member to the people attending the service.
- 3. After any remarks by the PIC, he will yell "Fall In!" and the attending Chapter Members will stand up and line up in a straight row behind the behind.
- 4. At this time, the Special Forces Creed and "Ballad of the Green Berets" will be displayed and played with the existing audio/visual system.
- 5. If an audio/visual system is not available, the "Ballad of the Green Berets" will be played on a boom box.
- 6. When the "Ballad of Green Berets' is played, the attending Chapter Members will sing along when the Ballad is played.
- 7. After the Ballad has played, the PIC using the list of the attending Chapter Members he had prepared, will yell out **"Answer Here When your Name Is Called!"**
- 8. When an attending Chapter Member's name is called, he will take one step forward, render a snappy salute and yell **"Here Sir!"** and step back in line.
- 9. The last name called by the PIC will be the Deceased Chapter Member as follows:
 - a. **"SMITH"** (or whatever the deceased's last name is) followed by silence.
 - b. **"SERGEANT MAJOR SMITH"** (or whatever the deceased's last name is and his last known rank) followed by silence.
 - c. **"SERGEANT MAJOR RAYMOND SMITH"** (or whatever the deceased first and last names are and his last known rank)
 - d. At that time, the Chapter Member who has been assigned to answer for the Deceased Chapter Member will do the following:
 - i. Step forward one step
 - ii. Render a snappy salute

- iii. Yell out very loudly saying "Sir, SERGEANT MAJOR RAYMOND SMITH has departed to prepare the final drop zone for a Safe Landing for all Chapter Members!"
- iv. Step back in line.
- e. At that time, the PIC will yell out **"FALL OUT!"** and the attending Chapter Members will be seated.
